His love for prayer and his eagerness to perform it in time. He was the first to enter the mosque, and his college colleagues said that he preceded them to the mosque, he was earliest preserving the time in Fajr prayer.

So congratulations to that pure spirit, and delightedness to this young man, he has made his most important tasks in life: (prayers), may God bless "Mahmoud alive and dead.

Dear young son.

Your prayers are your salvation, which is the path of a good life in this world, and the highest paradise in the Hereafter, so be the best worshiper, and make your prayers the first thing in your life to survive and be happy.

Mahmoud - may God rest his soul - was not only keen on praying obligatory prayerss, but rather his love extended to the supererogatory prayers (and so the good deeds call out to each other). He maintained the supererogatory prayers so he would never leave, and this is God's help to him. And one of his relatives said: In Ramadan this year, while they were traveling they put Maghrib and Isha prayers together and shortened. Mahmoud - may God rest his soul was very dedicated and sincere in his prayers.

His righteousness and obedience to his parents was ideal, hardly refuses any request from them, but he feels happiness while serving them.

Here is a message for every son and girl who consider that in the service of the parents is hardship and fatigue, so without this sincere obedience, none of your brothers precedes you.

Also his righteousness followed his relationship and brought pleasure to them.

The Qur'an was his companion, and recitation was his blessing, so he would never leave. Once he finished reciting Qur'an he starts once again especially in Ramadan.

Mahmoud performed Hajj when he was fifteen years old.

Mahmoud - may God rest his soul- was pure character, and everyone loved him. He was distinguished in his good conduct and manners.

Mahmoud - may God rest his soul - has one sister, whom he loved an respected very much.

He always hastened towards good deeds, such as fasting the six days of Shawwal; he was very keen on fasting the second day of Shawwal to achieve this.

- As for his love for charity and his initiative for it, it was outstanding, he was always sponsoring orphans and supporting charitable societies, and all for God's sake.
- May God rest his soul, he achieved outstanding and distinguished good deeds during his life time. He died drowned after praying Maghreb and Isha prayers. The Prophet peace be upon him said,:
 "Whoever's last words were: There is no God but Allah has entered paradise, and whoever fasted one day for God's sake enters paradise, and whoever gives alms with sincerity to seek the pleasure of God, he will be rewarded by entering the paradise" and Mahmoud's last deeds was dedication to prayers.
 - One can go on and on about the righteousness of this good young man, may God rest his soul, and such a good memory remains a momentum for the youth of the Ummah to follow such good examples, and each of them strives to come out of the world with such good deeds to help him in his life-to-come, and to be the best for him for the day of Judgement.
 - I conclude this article with sincere condolences to his parents, who showed patience on his parting, as he drowned in front of his mother, and was taken out in front of his father and mother, but the people praised them for their patience, as they try to accept God's decree. Patience and acceptance are the best reassurance for them because they are sure that God's command is effective, and the greatest thing to ease their pain is that their son was a good Muslim.
 - May His Lord reward them well and bring them and their children together in his mercy.

May God forgive Mahmoud and the dead of the Muslims, and reward the deeds well of our life time.
